Each party shall only use the other institution's confidential information which is communicated to it in connection with this LOC for the purpose for which it was communicated or with the permission of the communicating party.

Duration:

The duration of this LOC shall be for a period of three years from the date of signing.

- a) Where agreed to in writing by both institutions, this LOC may be amended.
- b) Either institution may terminate this LOC by giving twelve (12) months notice in writing to the other institution.
- c) This LOC does not constitute any financial commitment by either institution.
- d) This LOC is not intended to be legally binding and nothing in it shall be taken to create any legally binding contract, agreement or relationship between the institutions.
