DR. RADHA KRISHAN FOUNDATION FUND SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FROM KURUKSHETRA UNIVERSITY, KURUKSHETRA

Notification

Applications are invited for the award of Dr. Radha Krishan Foundation Fund Scholarship from the Under-graduate students studying in affiliated/maintained colleges of the University and from the Post-graduate students of the University Teaching Departments for the session 2018-19 as per details given below:-

- (i) 100 Scholarships (Merit-cum-Means basis) and 50 Scholarships (Mean basis) will be awarded to the students of Under-graduate classes studying in Part-1/ First Year on the basis of their lower examination i.e. 10+2 passed in April/May, 2018 securing at least 60% marks for science Stream students and 55% marks for other stream students.
- (ii) 55 Scholarships (Merit-cum-Means basis) and 25 Scholarships (Means basis) will be awarded to the Post-graduate students studying in previous/First Year classes of <u>University Teaching Departments</u> only on the basis of their lower examination i.e. B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./B.Sc. Home Sci./ B.C.A./ B.Lib. Sc./LLB (Final) etc. passed in April/May, 2018 securing at least 60% marks for Science Stream students and 55% marks for other Stream students.
- (iii) 50 Post graduate Scholarships of Below-Poverty-Line (BPL) card holder students will be awarded in the University Teaching Departments and 25 Under-graduate Below-Poverty-Line (BPL) card holder students will be awarded in the affiliated/maintained colleges.
- (iv) The Scholarship to one child of each deceased employee of the University @Rs. 250/- p.m. pursuing studies in the University.
- (v) All the Physically Handicapped Under-graduate students studying in affiliated/ maintained colleges and the Post-graduate students of University Teaching Departments with 50% to 79% Disability will be awarded scholarship Rs. 250/- per month and 300/- per month respectively. But the students with 80% or more disability with family income from all sources not exceeding Rs. 1,00,000/- (one lac) per annum studying in the University Teaching Departments and Colleges on the campus will only be eligible for award of Scholarship @ Rs. 1000/- per month out of K.U.K. Dr. Radha Krishan Foundation Fund. The applicant should submit an income certificate from the employer in case of employee, and in other cases in the form of an Affidavit duly attested by the 1s Class Magistrate.
- (vi) Scholarships for Under-graduate and Post-graduate students will be awarded to those students who have won National Level Bravery Award/President Medal.
- (vii) There is no percentage of marks from Sr. No. 5 to 6 and can apply in any year of the course/class.
- (viii) The duration of all these scholarships is 12 months. The rate of scholarships of Under-graduate and Post-graduate will be Rs. 250/- p.m. and Rs. 300/- p.m. respectively.
- (ix) If a student is receiving any other scholarship/Stipend/Financial Aid from any other source, he/she is not eligible to receive this scholarship. The Principal of the College/Head of the Institution/ Chairperson of the Departments will have to give a certificate to the effect that he/she has not received/receiving any other scholarship/stipend/Financial Aid etc.

- (x) The applicant must attach with the application form an attested copy of the DMC of the lower examination passed in April/May, 2018.
- (xi) The applicant must give the Annual total Income of the family from all sources in the application form. The annual total income should include income/Gross salary of both the parents/guardians. The income certificate/affidavit duly attested by the competent Authority must be attached with the application form.
- (xii) The Principals of all colleges are requested to kindly send the application forms of 2% of the total students' strength in 1st year course of Under-Graduate classes only.

RENEWAL OF DR. RADHA KRISHAN FOUNDATION FUND SCHOLARSHIP

All the Dr. R.K.F.F. Scholarships are tenable for the entire duration of the course/rest of the course but are renewable on year to year basis. The renewal of scholarship, placed at Sr. No. 1 to 4 are subject to the condition that the awardees should have passed the lower examination without re-appear securing at least 55% marks. (this applies to the students of all streams.) There is no condition of percentage of marks for the renewal of the scholarships from Sr. No. 5 to 6. All the awardees of this scholarship will have to submit a certificate of good conduct from the Principal/Head of the institution/Chairperson of the Department.

Applications complete in all respect on the prescribed Proforma (Specimen Proforma Attached) should reach the Deputy Registrar (Accounts-I), Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra through the Principal/Head of the Institution/Chairperson of the Department, upto 18-12-2018 positively. Incomplete applications and the applications received after 18-12-2018 will not be considered/entertained and such applications shall stand rejected automatically.
